

How CRN North West London has adapted to the implementation of HRA Approval

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Since 31 March 2016, HRA Approval has been the process for gaining approval for research in the NHS. As a number of functions transferred to the HRA, the role of the Research Management and Governance (RM&G) team in CRN North West London (CRN NWL) has gradually shifted.

Initially, the team supported local study set-up, including capacity and capability assessment and confirmation. In longer-term, however, we have aimed to enhance the support provided by the Research Facilitation team (former RM&G) to researchers in North West London by providing assistance throughout the study life cycle. Our goal is to fully implement the CRN Study Support Service for both commercial and non commercial studies, which helps researchers plan, set up and deliver research in the NHS.

- We create a **bespoke performance management (PM)** plan for each study
- Our PM report combines CPMS and LPMS data to **flag up any changes to study performance** that warrant an unscheduled review (Tables 1 & 2)
- The **single point of contact** works with all parties involved to identify, analyse and address challenges that may have arisen

- We help CIs to **identify local collaborators across the UK** so that their studies are delivered to time and target
- Through our network, we are able to approach **240+** NHS organisations and **7,000+** General Practices

- We have **50+ delivery staff** trained to undertake National Study Delivery Assessment (NSDA) to **identify potential challenges** to study delivery early on
- This informs delivery planning and the approach we take to performance manage our studies
